Caminito
Caminito is the most famous pedestrian street in Buenos Aires. It is one of the most popular tourist attractions in the city due to its colorful houses and its deep historical and cultural significance. Caminito is located in the popular neighborhood of La Boca, on the coast of the Riachuelo River and only 400 meters from La Bombonera, the Boca Juniors stadium. It is a 150-meter-long curved pedestrian promenade where important artistic works can be seen.

2. Mafalda Statue
The Monument to Mafalda is a sculpture dedicated to the most famous character of the cartoonist Quino: 'Mafalda' in which she could be seen materialized on a bench resting. The Monument to Mafalda is located a few meters from where the cartoonist lived, in the San Telmo neighborhood,

where a plaque that says 'Mafalda lived here' commemorates him.

3. Estadio Alberto J. Armando (La Bombonera) It is known by various international media as one of the most emblematic football stadiums in the world, and declared of "sports, tourist and cultural interest in the city of Buenos Aires", it was inaugurated on May 25, 1940. Diego Armando Maradona defined this stadium as "The Temple of the Mouth". Likewise, various sports glories such as Pelé, Zico, Andrés Iniesta, and Thierry Henry, among others, have declared that they have a good experience at the Boca Juniors stadium. The stadium has a capacity of 40,000 seated spectators and 57,000 seated and standing spectators. The entrance has a value of 10 USD

4. Avenida de Mayo
Inspired by the Gran Vía in Madrid, Avenida de Mayo is one of the largest and most important arteries in Buenos Aires. It runs through the city from Plaza de Mayo with the Casa Rosada at one end, to the National Congress building at the other. Officially opened in 1894, it is worth going through, as it is like taking a trip through the entire history of the city.

6. Casa Rosada
It is a palace located in front of the Plaza de Mayo that functions as the seat of the National Government. This imposing pink building occupies the site where the Fort of Buenos Aires was erected in 1580. It was the residence of Spanish viceroys and later housed, with some reforms, the authorities of successive national governments. The current building is the product of the merger of two previous constructions: the presidential headquarters and the Palacio de Correos (on the corner of Hipólito Yrigoyen and Balcarce).

📅**Sat 26 Oct 24 - Cusco City Tour & Nearby Archaeological sites**

Breakfast at the hotel. At around 1 pm, your guide will be waiting in the hotel lobby to start a 4-hour guided tour of this charming city, which was the capital of the Inca Empire. The tour starts with a visit to Santo Domingo Convent, a large Renaissance-baroque complex, which was built over the Inca Coricancha temple. It was one of the most important temples dedicated to worshipping the sun, and its foundations are still prominent at the base of the convent. Ancient chronicles say the temple was covered in gold leaf and filled with golden representations of nature. Then, visit the Cathedral, the most imposing monument of the Main Square. You will be transferred to the hills above Cusco to visit the remains of the fortress of Sacsayhuamn, whose imposing ramparts offer a stunning panoramic view of Cusco, the ruins of the temple and amphitheater of Qenqo, where it is believed the Incas practiced agricultural rituals. Admire Qenqo and then finally visit Puka Pukara (Red fortress in Quechua) an Inca military complex located on a prominent hill. Its dwellings squares, bathrooms, aqueducts, walls, and towers can still be appreciated. Afterward, return to your hotel at about 5.30 pm. Overnight in Cusco.

📅**Sun 27 Oct 2024: Cusco Machu Picchu Cusco (75 Km 2 hrs drive / 1.5 hrs by train)**¹

Early Breakfast at the hotel. Pick up at the hotel at around 4.30 am. The exact pickup time will be confirmed one day before. Transfer to Ollanta train station. Your tour to Machu Picchu begins with approximately one hour and a half train ride to Aguas Calientes. This town is also known as "Machu Picchu Pueblo". Upon arrival, you will be guided to the bus that takes you to Machu Picchu. After a 25-minute bus ride, you will finally arrive at the 'lost city of the Incas'. It is believed that Machu Picchu was built for the Inca emperor Pachactec around 1450 as a holiday residence. The citadel was abandoned just over 100 years later, probably as a result of the Spanish Conquest, although historians have never uncovered why it was abandoned or how it escaped the destruction that other Inca settlements faced. Instead, the jungle slowly engulfed its stone construction, covering it in thick vegetation that kept it hidden and protected until the lost city of the Incas was brought to international attention in 1911. Your 2.5-hour tour will introduce you to the origins of this impressive citadel and guide you around some of its most iconic monuments, such as the main square, the royal rooms, the Temple of the Three Windows, the circular towers, the Sacred Clock, and cemeteries. At the end of the tour, return by bus to Aguas Calientes for lunch. Finally, you will return by train to Ollanta Station and will be transferred to your hotel in Cusco in the late afternoon. Overnight in Cusco.
