Batu Caves

The magnificent Batu Caves are one of the top tourist attractions in Malaysia. this 100-year-old temple features idols and statues erected inside the main caves and around it. Incorporated with interior limestone formations said to be around 400 million years old, the temple is considered an important religious landmark by Hindus.

Petronas Twin Towers

During your visit to the Petronas Twin Towers, ride up to the observation deck, located about 557 feet (170 meters) above ground, and take unforgettable photos while you marvel at the cityscape from the Skybridge.

Chinatown

Head to Chinatown where you can stroll the streets and shop alleyways packed with food stalls selling a wide range of foods and local goods. Once you've mastered the art of negotiating for bargains.

Merdeka Square

See the magnificent Merdeka Square, a symbol of Malaysian independence and one of the most picturesque squares in the world. Admire architectural masterpieces of the modern and colonial era. A 95-meter flagpole, one of the tallest in the world, is located at the southern end of the square 15 minutes - Admission Ticket Free Central Market Kuala Lumpur Central Market (Pasar Seni), another indoor bazaar not far from Chinatown. The spacious market offers a variety of foods and distinctive souvenirs along with traditional Malaysian goods.

Perdana Botanical Garden

Visit the Lake Gardens and enjoy a moment away from the hustle and bustle of the city 15 mins - Admission Ticket Free National Mosque (Masjid Negara) Next, see the stunning National Mosque of Malaysia (Masjid Negara), set in 13 acres of beautiful gardens. Admire the bold approach taken by its architects who designed it in the late 1950s as a symbol of the aspirations of the newly independent nation.

National Monument

The National Monument is a sculpture that commemorates those who died in Malaysia's struggle for freedom, principally against the Japanese occupation during World War II and the Malayan Emergency, which lasted from 1948 until 1960.

The Malaysian equivalent to Buckingham Palace, Royal King's Palace (Istana Negara) attracts thousands of visitors with its golden domes and Islamic-style architecture. Although you cant explore the palace, you can learn about the Malaysian monarchy.

Lunch

The Coastal Tour takes you to several different natural habitats with the chance to observe land and sea birds, mangroves, and kangaroos. There will be ample time and plenty of opportunities to photograph the wonderful variety of environments and their inhabitants throughout the day. After pickup, you will drive to a location where mobs of Eastern Grey Kangaroos can be admired from a safe distance. In the early morning, large groups feed in the open grassland. With births occurring year-round, we can observe the young ones in their mother's pouches or staying close by. A short mangrove walk follows, where you can observe a great variety of waders, waterbirds, and aerial birds. You might also spot some perching birds, both large and small. We then drive to Osprey House*, where the environmental center has several lookouts, and you can gather information about the various habitats. From Osprey House, you will visit another bird hide and take a short walk/drive with amazing mangrove views. Continuing your Coastal Tour, drive across one of the longest bridges in Australia, the Houghton Highway, with its glorious views of Hays Inlet and The Glasshouse Mountains. There are two more mangrove lookouts on the way to the HMQS Gayundah shipwreck at Woody Point. The Gayundah was deliberately beached in the 1950s to act as a breakwater. Driving further around the coastline will stop to admire the spectacular view across to Moreton Island. This can be pretty breathtaking, especially on a clear blue day. Make time to dip our toes in the water and do some beach climbing. The tour finishes at the Scarborough Boat Harbour, where you will have the opportunity to buy fresh seafood at the legendary Morgans if you wish. There are plenty of coffee and lunch spots along the way but let me know beforehand if you would like a reservation for lunch at a particular caf or restaurant. If preferred, you can BYO as there are plenty of recreation areas with picnic tables on the route.
